Sewer Project:

The Clerk informed the Board that phase 3 will have to be re-bid due to the elimination of the UV filtration.

New Business:

Trash Contract – Open Bids:

Mayor Meek opened 2 bids and read them aloud.

Bid 1 was from R&W Container, Cameron, MO. Residential trash service \$10.00 and Senior Citizen trash service \$9.50.

Bid 2 was from Redgate Disposal, Edgerton, MO. Residential trash service \$13.23 and Senior Citizen trash service \$12.75.

After some discussion, a motion was made by Alderman Magness, second by Alderman Bradford to award the trash contract to R&W Container, Cameron, MO. Motion passed 3-0.

Alderman Comments:

Mayor Meek discussed his recent water/sewer bill. He would like for the Board to forgive the bill due to a toilet running while he wasn't home. The running toilet used 36,000 gallons and he is not going to pay the bill. Alderman Bradford wants Abraham to check David's meter to make sure there isn't something wrong with the meter before any further discussion. The Board agreed to wait until next month to discuss David's water/sewer bill.
