## **Sewer Project:**

The City Clerk presented the Board with two options for the sewer project.

Option #1 is to re-bid and include the improvements to the electrical at the lift station at the lagoon.

Option #2 is to be done and pay the remaining engineer fee's out of the Rural Development loan funds.

After some discussion at motion was made by Alderman Baumgarden, second by Alderman Bradford to put phase 3 out for re-bid with the SAGR system and include the electrical improvements at the lift station at the lagoon with no alternates. Motion passed 3-0.
