3.8% Water loss. The voluntary water conservation is no longer in effect.

#### **Sewer Project:**

The City Clerk explained that the engineers are requesting an additional \$10,000 before they will proceed with the new bid package. The Clerk also explained that Stan Wolfe, USDA didn't believe the state engineer would approve the new concept of putting the SAGR system as an alternate. After some discussion the Board decided to table any decisions until the Clerk has time to research the options that the City has at this point.

#### **New Business:**

#### **Alderman Comments:**

Alderman Bradford wanted to know why Mike wasn't doing any work on the streets. Mike explained that there isn't really anything he can do to fix the streets because they are that bad and any rock put on them is a waste of money. The Board agreed that putting rock down is a waste of money. The Clerk stated that it may be a waste of money but at this point that is the City's only option. After further discussion a motion was made by Alderman Bradford, second by Alderman Magness for the Clerk to find a way to fund street improvements and to get prices to chip and seal Emma and Georgie streets. Motion passed 4-0.
