
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13 OF ORDINANCE WW1970-1
RULES AND REGULATIONS; OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF OSBORN, MISSOURI BY ESTABLISHING RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM
TO BE CONSTRUCTED AND OWNED BY THE CITY OF OSBORN, MISSOURI.**

WHERE AS, the City operates and maintains waterworks for the provision of a municipal water system; and

WHERE AS, the City must pay the operation and maintenance expenses associated with said waterworks system and must charge the users of such water accordingly; and

WHERE AS, the board of Alderman have determined and declared it to be necessary and conducive to the protection of the public health, safety, welfare and convenience of the City to collect charges for all users of the City's water system; and

WHERE AS, the proceeds derived from such charges will be used for the purpose of operating and maintaining said water system;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF
THE CITY OF OSBORN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. BILLS.

The City may hand deliver 24 hour notices for residents that have an outstanding balance on the 30th of each month but there will be an additional charge of \$25.00 for the door hanger, this will be charged to the account each time a 24 hour notice is given. This will have to be paid, along with the late bill if services are disconnected.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. The forgoing changes are the only modifications or amendments of section 13 of Ordinance WW1970-1, intended by this action of the board of Aldermen and in all other respects Ordinance WW1970-1, shall remain in full force and effect as enacted and heretofore amended.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage and approval.
