AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF OSBORN, MISSOURI; PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATIONS FOR DRIVEWAY TUBES INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF OSBORN, MISSOURI.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN OF THE CITY OF OSBORN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All replacements and future installation of culverts and tubes under or upon private or public lands and across ditches and alongside of streets shall be of corrugated galvanized steel or of an equivalent material of a size and gauge not less than sixteen (16) gauge prescribed by the City, but no less than ten (10) inches in diameter or less than sixteen (16) feet in length nor longer than thirty (30) feet in length.

Section 2. The City public works employee will inspect the location and depth of all tubes if the City doesn't install the tube.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
